Sapper Ale

Twenty Twelve is the Bicentenary of the Corps. By way of promoting the Corps of Royal Engineers, arrangements have been made with the brewers Shepherds and Neame to brew Sapper Ale. They brew Spitfire Ale and Bishops Finger. The latter is remarkably good as it is named after me. The packaging is attractive and we are told it has a shelf life of one year. It will be on sale at Christmas 2011 and also into 2012 and beyond. The Corps charities will benefit from the sales. This gives us a greater incentive to develop a palette that couldn't do without a thirst quenching drink of Sapper Ale. If production has started by the time we have the re-union, maybe we could get it off to a flying start, and ask the hotel to take it on stock. You could ask your local off licence or supermarket to stock it. Full details of Sapper Ale are available on the JL web site on the Documents section. There are also photos of the proposed labelling that may well be used.
